

Horse Force Winter Schooling Series 2010

Basic Rules and Regulations

- Schooling will be confined to warm up arena/area with schooling fences provided.
- The committee reserves the right to cancel any classes in which there are less than three entries or to combine them suitably.
- The committee reserves the right to change the order of classes in case of darkness, inclement weather, or in the interest of time.
- No person will be permitted in the show rings during judging except those having duties to perform.
- Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the entry fees of all the horses entered by them or their agents. Horses must be scratched prior to the start of a class in order for the entry fee to be refunded.
- The committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return the entry fee before or during the show without being liable for compensation.
- Care should be taken to enter each horse correctly. Age of horses, along with their description must be stated. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors, and those of their agents. Please include all necessary card numbers.
- Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in these rules they shall be referred to the show steward, whose decision will be final.
- Anyone creating a disturbance will be removed from the grounds. The judge may excuse a horse/pony from any class that is unruly or unsound.
- All riders must be suitably attired and must wear USEF approved head gear at all times when mounted.
- Proof of negative Coggins must accompany entry or be shown to show secretary in order to pick up numbers.
- Post entries will be taken up to the beginning of the class.
- SEI/ASTM/USEF approved protective helmets with attached chin straps are mandatory for all English Riders 17/under and anyone jumping. They are optional (and encouraged) for all other riders.
- A judge or show official shall have the authority to disqualify or exclude from participation any horse that is not considered to be safely manageable, and as such could be considered hazardous to either exhibitors or spectators.
- Attire – this is a winter series – show clothes are not required. However, for safety reasons, hard-soled shoes/boots with a heel must be worn while mounted.
- No martingales are allowed except in hunter over fences classes.
- Dogs should be left at home.
- Questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by Management, whose decision shall be final.
- Children are NOT to be left unattended
